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1. General description of the data set, and IRB Approval # (if available):

The PHONODIS corpus was developed at Centro de Linguística da Universidade de Lisboa (CLUL) and supported by Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia (PEst-OE/LIN/UI0214/2013; UID/LIN/00214/2019). The corpus is based on the criteria adopted within the Crosslinguistic Child Phonology Project (University of British Columbia; UBC), coordinated by Barbara May Bernhardt and Joseph Stemberger. PHONODIS contains experimental cross-sectional data collected by three Speech and Language Therapists (SLTs: Marisa Lousada, Patrícia Oliveira, Margarida Ramalho).
