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1. General description of the data set, and IRB Approval # (if available):

The corpus contains audio-recordings of 120 typically-developing native Turkish speaker children between the ages of 2;0 to 7;11. All participants named pictures in an articulation test, which consist of 93 words that include all consonant phonemes and three allophones of Turkish. Each speech sound is tested at four positions: Word initially, syllable initially within the word, syllable finally within the word, and word finally.

The parents of all participants signed the Consent Form, which explains Phon's ethical rules and the aim of the current research project. The study was approved by the ethics committee of the Istanbul Medipol University.
